In 2024, production from renewable technologies increased by 7% - with a record share of 50.8% of electricity generated.




Generation from fossil fuels dropped to levels not seen since the 1950s (16% reduction).

In January 2025, Wind led the way for the biggest contribution of power coming from renewable sources. Overall, renewable sources accounted for 42.3% of all UK energy production in this timeframe.

Solar - 4.7%



Biomass - 6.8%



Hydro - 1.3%



All Renewables - 42.3%

OFFSHORE WIND COULD HOLD THE SOLUTION TO SLIPPAGES FROM OIL & GAS

Robert Gordon University (RGU) has stated that the rise of offshore wind will be critical to counteracting job losses happening in a shrinking oil & gas industry.

But the reality for offshore wind offsetting losses in oil & gas isn't plain sailing...



The oil & gas industry is currently forecasted to lose the equivalent of 400 jobs every two weeks by the early 2030s.



There's likely to be limited capacity for UK offshore to accommodate this decline (as of 2025), with a lack of joined up action potentially making the path to net zero even more challenging.
